Summary:

Rebecca Kaiser Gibson is the author of *OPINEL* (Bauhan Publishing, 2015), and two chapbooks, *Admit the Peacock* and *Inside the Exhibition*. She is the recipient of fellowships from the Macdowell Colony, The Heinrich Böll Cottage in Ireland, and the 2008 Fellowship in Poetry from the Massachusetts Cultural Council. She was selected as a Fulbright Scholar to teach poetry in Hyderabad, India, 2011.

Her poems have appeared in *Agni*, *Field*, *The Greensboro Review*, *The Harvard Review*, *Salamander*, *Slate*, *The Taos Journal of International Poetry and Art*, *The Tupelo Quarterly*, and featured in *VerseDaily* among others. Her poems are included in two anthologies, *Cadence of Hooves and Thirty Days*, *The Best of the Tupelo Press 30/30 Project's First Year*.
